Dallas receives state grant to help build Rickreall trail

The city of Dallas has received a \$224,220 state grant to build a section of the Rickreall Creek Trail.

The award by Oregon Parks and Recreation Department was part of a sponsor match and is allotted for the construction of the River Gleann section of the trail. The sponsor match is \$580,002. The total project will cost \$804,222.

Dallas is one of 26 local government agencies to share more than \$4 million in state lottery-supported grants for park and trail improvements.

Other awards include \$500,000 to Woodburn for the construction of a baseball field, non-motorized trails, day use picnicking areas a dog park and other amenities at Centennial Park. Aurora City Park received \$240,000 for various improvements, including ADA accessible parking, pathways, a picnic shelter and invasive species removal.

Mill City received \$25,000 and Amity \$7,280 to update city parks and recreation master plans.
